The IMUB opens a call for a one-year full-time Junior Postdoctoral Position in all areas of mathematics. Starting date is expected to be September 1st, 2020, though some flexibility is possible.

Requirements for applying:

- Having defended a PhD thesis after December 2016 in a center not belonging to Universitat de Barcelona.
- A minimum of two years of doctoral or postdoctoral experience outside of Catalonia.

- A motivation letter (at most 1 page) specifying previous contacts/collaborations with <u>research groups at IMUB</u>, and desired starting date (please keep in mind that August is not eligible for academic or administrative procedures).
- A Curriculum Vitae (at most 3 pages) and a list of publications.
- A research proposal (at most 4 pages).
- Copy of the Ph.D. degree certificate, or formal proof of the expected date of defense (such as a scanned pdf signed by your PhD supervisor, head of the Department...etc), which should take place before 31st of August 2020.
- A letter of reference by a <u>member of IMUB</u> stating the acceptance of the applicant in her/his research group.
- Name, affiliation and email of two members of academic institutions able to provide a letter of reference for the candidate.
- Evidence proving two years of work experience outside Catalonia (PhD can suffice or scanned contracts/grant, for instance).

Timeline:

Deadline for applications: March 15th, 2020. Tentative dates for interviews: April 15-30.

Conditions:

Gross salary: 19.000/year.

Research funds: These will come from the host research group

and will depend on availability.

Medical insurance: Medical coverage for the fellow and family

will be provided through the public health system.

Evaluation and Selection process:

Applications will be evaluated by an evaluation committee formed by members of the IMUB with collaboration from external referees. Short-listed candidates will be interviewed (perhaps remotely). The successful candidate will receive a letter of invitation and she/he will be given a period of two weeks to accept or decline the offer. If the appointment is declined, it will be offered to the next candidate in the reserve list. Once the appointment is accepted, the name and research project will be posted in the IMUB website.
